

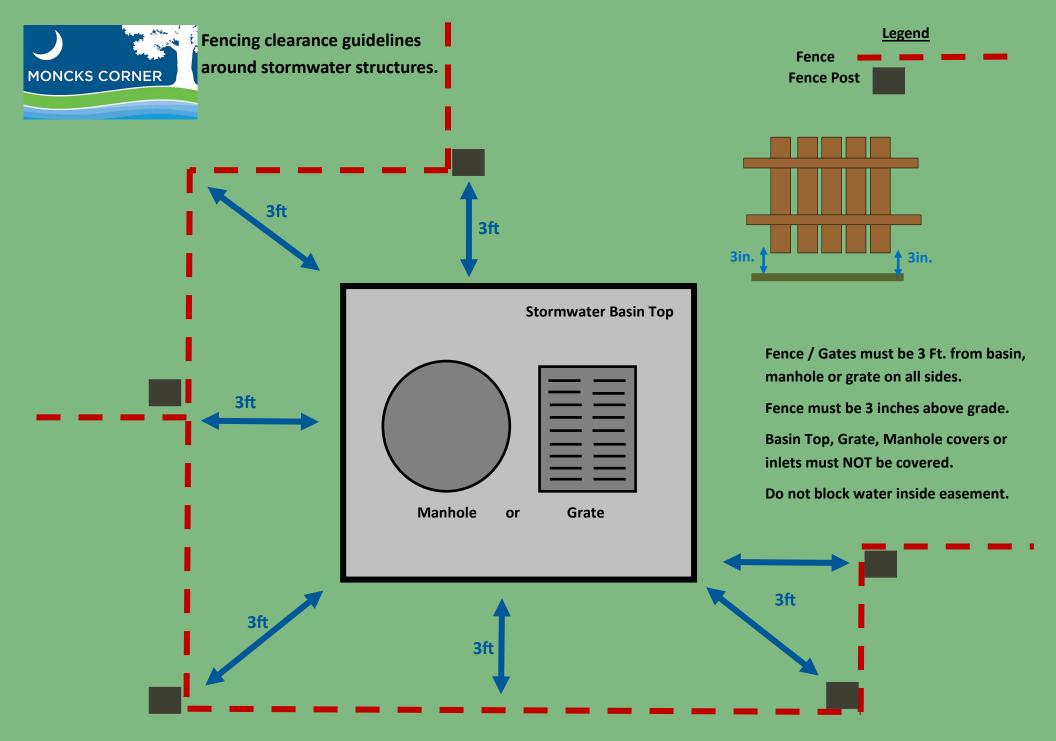
REQUIREMENTS FOR FENCES

Generally speaking, screening walls and fences are allowed without a permit within the Town of Moncks Corner. However, there are some requirements that must be met to ensure that safety and environmental needs are met. These include:

- A. The fence or wall may not impede visibility of motorists on the street or in the driveway
- B. The fence or wall may not include gates that swing outward into sidewalks or public rights-ofway
- C. Fences or walls may not exceed seven feet (7') in height in side or rear yards.
- D. Fences or walls may not exceed three feet (3') in height in front yards.
- E. No fence that is taller than five feet (5') may be permitted within five feet (5') of a residential structure on adjacent property
- F. Chain link fences are not permitted in residential areas, and shall not be visible from the right-of-way in non-residential areas
- G. The finished side of the fence must face outwards from the subject property
- H. For permitting (if applicable), please show the proposed location of the fence on plat or aerial map of the property
- I. If the fence will be placed within any drainage easement or facilities, an Encroachment Permit shall be required from Moncks Corner Building & Codes Enforcement, subject to the following parameters:
 - 1. The proposed fence is set back at least three feet (3') from any storm drain basin
 - 2. The proposed fence is at least three inches (3") above the finished grade of the easement
 - 3. An encroachment permit has been issued from Town Building & Codes Enforcement
